


## INSTALLATION AND CARE

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Remove all bottle cage mount bolts from your frame and set aside. (4mm or 5mm hex)
- 2. Install straps on pack and attach both straps loosely to the top tube. The bag should be free to move around a bit.
- 3. Unzip the bag fully.
- 4. Put a washer on one of your bolts and insert it through the hole in one of the shims.



5. Holding the bolt, put the shim in the bag and thread the bolt through the correct grommet.



- 6. Line the bolt up and screw the bolt in with your fingers, leaving it a little bit loose.
- 7. Put washers on the other bolts and insert them through the shims and then through the grommets. Screw the bolts in, leaving them a little bit loose.

- 8. Once all the bolts are in use a hex wrench to tighten things up. Don't overtighten the bolts as the threads on bottle cage mounts are usually made of aluminum and can be easily stripped. The rubber grommet should allow you to get the bolt snug and should provide a solid mount.
- 9. If a strap is too long you can do two things. 1. You can trim the loop (soft) end of the strap. Trim the corners a bit to help prevent fraying. 2. You can cut the strap webbing if it's too long. i.e. if the webbing wraps all the way around your frame. Cut on the OUTSIDE of the cut seam and melt the edges gently with a lighter.



10. Load some gear in your bag and go for a ride!

## CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Your teknikul frame bag is pretty tough, but you do need to treat it right. Here are some do's and don'ts:

- DON'T put anything sharp in your frame bag without taking steps to prevent punctures from the inside of your bag.
- DON'T wash your frame bag in the washing machine. That could damage the X-PAC laminated fabric. DO wipe your frame bag clean with a sponge or soft rag soaked in warm soapy water. Or just leave the dirt on it so you look tough.
- DO ride with your frame bag on your bike every day! Or every day you can, at least.
